

# Direct to Rubber Technique

This technique uses Stampin' Write Markers and solid image stamps. It's easy and a great way to easily add different colours to one stamp.



Colour directly onto the rubber on your stamp. In this example I used Real Red Stampin' Write marker on the strawberry and Old Olive Stampin' Write maker on the top and stem.



Add moisture back onto the stamp (after you are finished colouring) by breathing on the stamp. This is called "huffing".

Stamp your image on the paper. You can see that the top of the strawberry is "green" and the fruit is "red".
