### Instructions

1. Fold the Pool Party cardstock in half to create card front.
2. Run the front of the Pool Party card through the Big Shot with the Honeycomb folder.
3. Cut an oval shape out of Typeset DSP and a larger oval shape from the Crumb Cake cardstock as the layer.
4. Stamp the Butterflies (as shown) on the Typeset DSP with Memento Black ink. Stamp one large butterfly on the Very Vanilla piece.
5. Colour the butterflies in with the Pool Party and Hello Honey inks.
6. Punch out the single large butterfly from Very Vanilla piece with the Elegant Butterfly Punch. Pop up on the stamped butterfly with a dimensional.
7. Layer the stamped oval on the Crumb Cake oval and glue both to the top half of the card front.
8. Cut the "plate" from the Hello Honey scrap using the framelit from Project Life Framelits.
9. Stamp the sentiment on Very Vanilla piece and punch out with oval punch. Layer on Hello Honey framelit using a dimensional. Glue to front of card below the oval.
10. Add Rhinestones to either side of sentiment and to center of punched butterfly.
