

# Alison's Card Share – September 2015

## Merry Christmas



### Instructions:

1. Fold the Very Vanilla cardstock in half to create card base.
2. Stamp the sentiment in Old Olive on the Very Vanilla piece.
3. Cut out the Santa image from the Home for Christmas DSP and pop up on the left side of tag with Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Glue the DSP in the center of the card front and the second piece offset on the first.
5. Cut two pieces of ribbon (3" long), layer one on top of the other and staple to the back of the tag so the tails hang out. Cut the tails to form a banner.
6. Tie the Baker's Twine in a bow and glue to button with glue dot.
7. Glue button to the tag with a glue dot.
8. Pop up the stamped tag on the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Enjoy!
