140736 Apple Of My Eye Photopolymer

Paper:

119683 Daffodil Delight (4 x 3")

138434 Brights Designer Series Paper Stack
(Daffodil Delight Stripped 5 ¼" x ½")

Ink:

132708 Tuxedo Black Memento

134576 Basic Black Baker's Twine

137856 Itty Bitty Accents Epoxy Stickers

138416 White Perfect Accents

104430 Stampin' Dimensionals

104332 Snail Adhesive

Black Sharpie Marker

Instructions

1. Colour the large and small circles from the Itty Bitty Accents Epoxy Stickers and the smallest Perfect Accents with a black sharpie marker. Colour them on the backing paper and be sure to colour right down to the edges. Leave them on the backing papers to dry.
2. Fold the white card base in half.
3. Punch out the flowers from the 5 ¼" x 4" piece of white cardstock. Slide the punch in from the left end of the cardstock.
4. Stamp the saying with the Memento Black ink on the same piece of white cardstock.
5. Attach the strip of Designer Paper to the bottom of the punched, stamped piece of cardstock.
6. Wrap the Baker's Twine (20") around the cardstock twice and tie in the front of the cardstock with a bow.
7. Add dimensionals to the back side of the punched piece around the flowers (add lots) and in the corners.
8. Put SNAIL adhesive on one side of the Daffodil Delight cardstock. Attach this piece to the back of card so that the unglued part shows through the front of the card.
9. Attach the punched panel to the front of the card base.
10. Add the coloured black circles to the middle of the flowers. They are easy to pick up with your fingers or slide a paper piercing tool or tip of scissors underneath them to grab them. They are self-adhesive. Press down firmly to attach.
